



## Transport from Geneva airport to IEC Central Office and to the city centre (Gare Cornavin)

### By taxi

- Approx. 12 min drive to the IEC Central Office. Price ranges from CHF 35.- to CHF 45.- depending on traffic condition, time of day and number of passengers.

### By bus No. 5 Thônex-Vallard

- Approx. 15 min to the IEC Central Office - stop: Nations or Varembe
  - Approx. 15 min to the city centre - stop: Gare Cornavin

**Note:** You can pick up a free ticket for public transport from the machine in the baggage collection area at the arrival level. This unireso ticket, offered by Genève Aéroport, allows you to use public transport in Geneva free for a period of 80 min.


### By tram No. 15 Nations


